

- As the evening sets in, gather around for a dinner and enjoy the crisp mountain air

- After soaking in the morning sun, devour a delicious breakfast and board the traveler for the journey ahead
- Begin your scenic road journey towards Sangla, nestled in the beautiful Kinnaur district of Himachal Pradesh.
- Enjoy the breathtaking landscapes as we pass through Kufri, Narkanda, and lush valleys along the way
- Reach Sangla by evening and check-in to our stay. Spend the night in the lap of nature – this will be your acclimatization day to help your body adjust to higher altitudes.

- Return to Kaza by evening and enjoy a warm Tibetan dinner before relaxing in the crisp mountain air.

- Our journey today takes us deeper into Spiti Valley, with an exciting stop at Gue
 Village, home to a 500-year-old naturally preserved mummy of a Buddhist monk.
- Next, we'll visit the Tabo Monastery, a UNESCO Heritage Site over 1,000 years old, known for its ancient murals and spiritual ambiance.
- By afternoon, we'll reach Kaza, the heart of Spiti Valley. After checking in, explore the charming local streets and visit the Kaza Monastery.
- In the evening, enjoy a delicious Spitian dinner at a local café or homestay, ending the day on a perfect note.

Travel Time - 4 To 5 Hrs Meals - Breakfast & Dinner


- As the morning sun lights up the, enjoy a freshly prepared breakfast before we set off for one of the trip's most awaited highlights—Chandratal Lake.

- Al-Based Tools: We employ Al-based tools like ConfirmTicket to predict the probability of your ticket being confirmed.
- Booking Strategy: Tickets are booked based on maximum confirmation probability, depending on the remaining days until departure.

2. Confirmation Disclaimer:

- No Guarantee: The tool does not guarantee 100% confirmation for waitlisted and RAC (Reservation Against Cancellation) tickets.
- Limited Control: Maharashtra Desha Adventure does not control ticket confirmations; it is managed by IRCTC, a government body.
- RAC Tickets: There is a possibility of receiving a RAC (half-seat) ticket instead of a confirmed seat. Maharashtra Desha Adventure is not responsible for the lack of confirmed tickets.
