Overview

Kalu Waterfall Trek -

Kalu Waterfall, nestled near the scenic Malshej Ghat in Maharashtra, is a hidden gem in the Western Ghats known for its impressive height and mesmerizing natural beauty. Located close to the village of Khubi in Thane district, this seasonal waterfall plunges from approximately 400 feet, making it one of the tallest in the region. The falls are fed by the Kalu River, which courses through the rugged terrain and dramatically cascades down the mountainside, creating a spectacular visual display, especially during the monsoon season.

- 02:00-03:00 PM: After lunch, rest and relax. Start the return journey to Mumbai/ Pune. Ensure you have all your belongings and leave no trace in the village or the forest.
- 09:00- 10:30 PM: Approximate arrival back in Mumbai/Pune. Reflect on the day's adventure and share memories of the lush trails, scenic views, and waterfalls encountered during the trek.
