Overview

Kedarnath is one of the holy and the most sacred pilgrim abode of Lord Shiva who is considered the embodiment of all passions - love, hatred, fear, death, and mysticism which are expressed through his various forms. It is situated in the Rudrapur district of the Garhwal region in Uttarakhand and every year thousands of pilgrims visit this place to seek blessing from Lord Shiva. It is one of the Char Dhams in Uttarakhand and is regarded as the most important among the Panch Kedar. This holy abode is positioned at an altitude of 3,586 meters with the mesmerizing backdrop of the magnificent Kedarnath range near the gorgeous river Mandakini, Kedarnath is one of the twelve Jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva. Even the name of this shrine also has a strong meaning "Kedar " which means powerful which is another name of Lord Shiva, the protector, and destroyer. The spectacular aura, snow-clad mountains, and breathtaking landscape makes the Kedarnath trek even more interesting and hence people visit in large numbers every year. Kedarnath is one of the important pilgrimages of Lord Shiva but there are more than 200 shrines dedicated to Lord Shiva in the area itself. So, plan your visit to Kedarnath....!!

🕒 Day 1

DAY 01 – Start Journey Towards Delhi

📍 Mumbai | Pune

- We board the Train from Bandra Terminus Or (Lokmanya Tilak Terminus), Depends on Train (Pls confirm train name and timings at booking time) To Delhi / Haridwar Individuals originating from Pune commence their travel in Train, subsequently uniting with us at Boarding station



🕒 Day 2

Reach Delhi and Start Journey towards Haridwar

📍 Delhi | Haridwar

- Upon arrival in Delhi, our journey will commence towards Haridwar via train or bus. We anticipate reaching Haridwar in the evening. Renowned as the "Devbhoomi" of India, located in Uttarakhand, Haridwar holds significant cultural and spiritual importance.
- Upon reaching Haridwar, we will proceed with hotel check-in arrangements and accommodation for the duration of our stay
- Attend Ganga aarti in evening at Hari ki pauri

🕒 Day 3

Haridwar To Sonprayag / GuptKashi

📍 Sonprayag

- In the early morning, we commence our journey to Sonprayag via bus, relishing the scenic views of the Ganga throughout the trip.
- A short stop is planned at Devprayag to witness the confluence of the Alaknanda and the Bhagirathi, giving rise to the sacred Ganga River.
- Upon reaching Sonprayag, arrangements for hotel accommodation/home stay/ camping will be made. We will have an overnight stay at Sonprayag, Guptkashi, or Sitapur, as per the arrangement



Day 4

Kedarnath Trek

📍 Kedarnath

- We start our journey Sonprayag to Gaurikund by local Taxi. Our Actual 21km Trek starts from Gaurikund. In route, we will encounter various camps such as Jungle Chatti, Bheembali, and Linchauli. On the opposite side of the path, a poignant sight awaits us – the remnants of the old route to Kedarnath, severely affected by the intense floods of 2013.
- Arriving at Kedarnath in the afternoon, we will proceed with check-in at a hotel/ homestay/ tent accommodation. Subsequently, a visit to the Kedarnath Temple is planned,
- In evening we also witness Kedarnath temple aarti. Enjoy a serene moment by the banks of the rushing Mandakini River, capturing the picturesque valley views.
- Return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Kedarnath.

Day 5

Return To Sonprayag / Gupt Kashi

📍 Sonprayag

- After witnessing the enchanting sunrise at the temple, featuring the magnificent Kedarnath peak adorned in golden hues, we initiate our descent to Gaurikund early in the morning.
- Upon reaching Sonprayag by afternoon, we promptly check-in at our pre-arranged hotel/ homestay/ tent accommodation. Our accommodation in Sonprayag / Sitapur will extend throughout the night



Day 6

Return Journey to Rishikesh

📍 Rishikesh

- In the morning, we will proceed to Rishikesh, renowned as the global hub for yoga. Upon arrival in Rishikesh, we will promptly check-in at our designated hotel / Hostel / camp for our stay.
- In the evening you can go for Ganga Aarti on Triveni Ghat

Day 7

Rishikesh To Haridwar

📍 Haridwar

- Experience thrilling adventure sports such as river rafting and bungee jumping. Additionally, partake in the Ganga Aarti ceremony along the banks of the Ganga River in Haridwar and also Explore Haridwar and some time for shopping .
- 4:00PM we start return journey towards delhi reach Delhi by 9:00 PM
- Stay arrangements will be there for Mumbai / Pune participants to catch train on next day

👉 Things to Carry

Backpacks / Bags

- One large backpack with a rain cover
- Raincoat (compulsory)
- One medium size bag (apx 20 to 30ltr for sonpryag to Kedarnatht trek)

Shoes / Footwears

- One pair of sports shoes.
- 3 pairs of knee-length socks.

Trek pants / Trousers

- These are quick dry in nature and are good while travelling. You can use them in some situations and also they are very lightweight hence are easy to carry.



Winter Jackets (compulsory)

- Even if you are travelling in peak summer never forget to carry at least one winter jacket. Elderly people may need more clothing

Your favourite clothes / traditional attires

- Many people carry their favourite wearables and wear them at the Kedarnath temple and click pictures. You must also try it out.

A thermal flask (Optional)

- The weather is cold at the top so you may carry a thermos flask to keep some warm water, coffee or tea to stay warm.

Carry water bottles/ bladder

- At high altitudes, our bodies get dehydrated really fast so you should definitely carry extra water bottles with you.

Snacks: Carry some energy bars or dry fruits for instant energy.

- Tissue paper and wet wipes Sanitizer, Paper Soap/ Squeezy handwashing bottles
- Sunscreen and Sunglasses

When You are trekking to the Kedarnath Temple

- Carry a medium-sized carry bag
- Keep a waist bag
- Keep knee wraps or knee caps. These are great for hiking and I am telling you from my personal experience.
- Carry extra water bottles



- Carry ready-to-eat snacks, dry fruits and energy bars
- Wear Sunglass and use Sunscreen
- Carry tissue papers and wet wipes.
- Handgloves / Monkey cap to prevent from cold
- Keep a power bank
- Carry ample cash with you as you may not find an ATM everywhere and not all the shops accept UPI Payment.
- Carry some medicines for cold, fever, loose motion, gas, headache etc. as per your requirement.
- Need to carry blanket for train journey
- Id card with 2 photocopy
- Head Torch / hand torch

🔍 FAQ

1. What is the best time to visit Kedarnath from Mumbai/Pune?

The best time to visit Kedarnath is from **May to June** and **September to October**. The temple opens in late April or early May and closes around **Diwali (October/November)** due to heavy snowfall in winter.



2. How to reach Kedarnath from Mumbai or Pune?

You can reach Kedarnath from Mumbai/Pune via the following routes:

By Air

- Fly from **Mumbai/Pune to Dehradun (Jolly Grant Airport)**.
- Take a taxi or bus from **Dehradun to Sonprayag/Gaurikund** (Approx. 220 km, 8-10 hours).
- Trek **16 km from Gaurikund to Kedarnath** or take a **helicopter** from Phata/Sersi.

By Train

- Take a train from **Mumbai/Pune to Haridwar or Rishikesh**.
- From Haridwar/Rishikesh, take a **bus or taxi** to Sonprayag/Gaurikund.

By Road

- Drive or take a bus to **Haridwar/Rishikesh** and then travel to Sonprayag.
- Private taxis and buses are available from **Delhi, Haridwar, and Rishikesh**.

3. What are the trekking options to Kedarnath?

- Trek from Gaurikund (16 km, moderate to difficult terrain).
- Pony/Doli (Horse/Palanquin services available at Gaurikund).
- Helicopter Services (Available from Phata, Sersi, and Guptkashi).



4. What are the accommodation options in Kedarnath?

- **Hotels & Guesthouses:** Available in **Gaurikund, Sonprayag, Guptkashi, and Rudraprayag.**
- **GMVN (Garhwal Mandal Vikas Nigam) Guesthouses:** Basic but affordable.
- **Dharmshalas:** Available near the temple for budget travelers.

6. What permits and registrations are required?

- **Kedarnath Yatra Registration** (Online or at Haridwar/Rishikesh).
- **Biometric Registration** (Compulsory, done online or at registration counters).

7. What are the food options available?

- Vegetarian food is widely available.
- Langars (free meals) are provided at certain places.
- Carry dry snacks and energy bars for the trek.

8. What are the important things to carry?

- Warm clothes, raincoat, gloves, cap, and trekking shoes.
- Personal medicines, energy bars, and hydration packs.
- ID proof and Kedarnath Yatra registration documents.

9. Is mobile network and ATM availability good in Kedarnath?

- **Limited network coverage** (BSNL, Jio work best).



- **ATMs available in Rudraprayag and Guptkashi**
(Carry enough cash).

10. Is there an option for Helicopter service to Kedarnath?

Yes, helicopter services are available from **Phata, Sersi, and Guptkashi**. Advance booking is recommended.

12. Can I visit Badrinath along with Kedarnath?

Yes, Kedarnath and Badrinath are part of the **Char Dham Yatra**. After Kedarnath, travel to Badrinath via **Rudraprayag and Joshimath** (Approx. 220 km).
